Edpuzzle is an app that allows you to add questions directly to a video. It is an easy and effective way to deliver videos in the classroom and check for understanding. Questions pop up as the video plays.

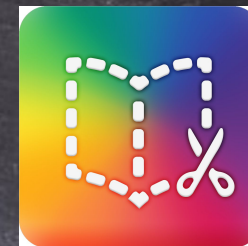
- ★ The YouTube world is your resource

- ★ It is easy to add questions and adjust where they show in a video
- ★ You can set-up the video to prevent students from skipping parts.



Seesaw is a platform that creates a powerful learning loop between students, teachers, and families. Students can post using photos, videos, drawings, text, PDFs, and links. Teachers can post directly to the student journal, send announcements to families and students, and assign activities and give feedback to students.

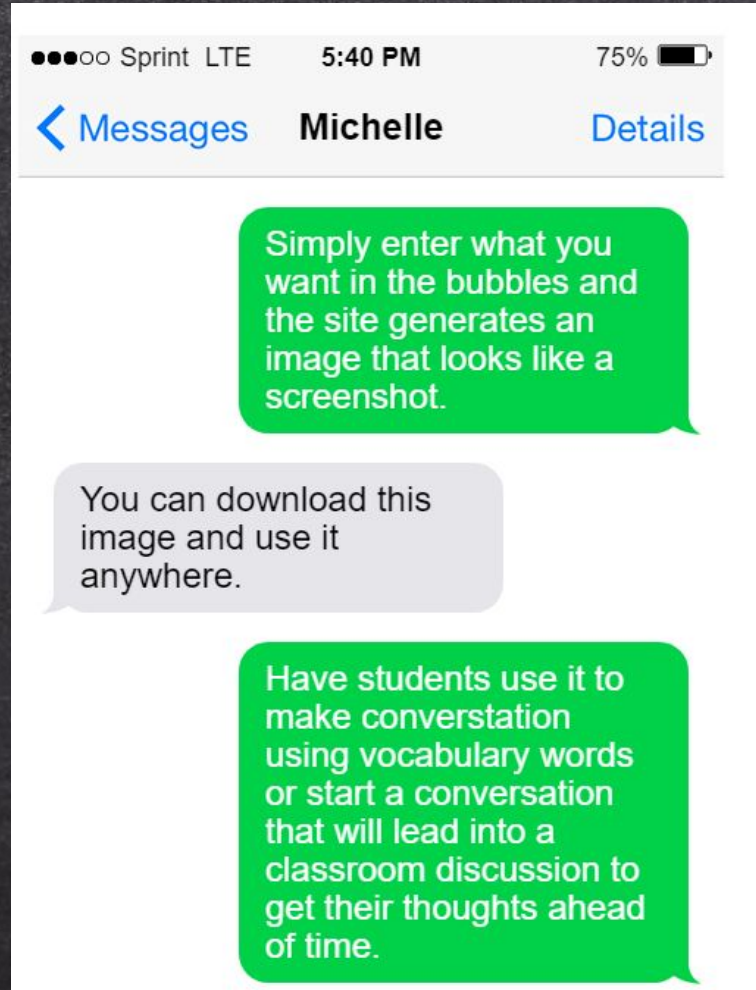

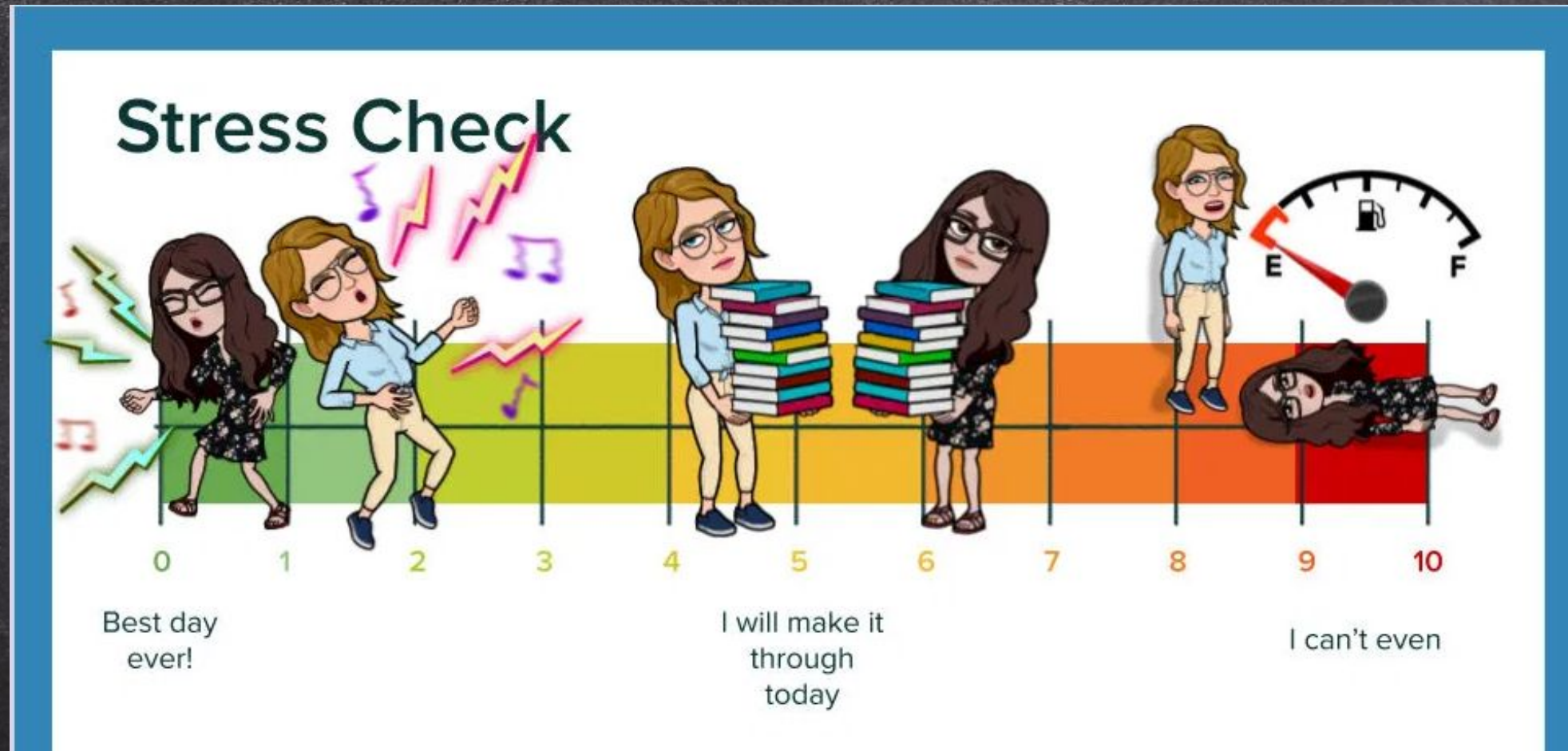
